Eligibility Criteria:

Primary Author of Nominated Paper

- Canadian Sociological Association membership in good standing
- Undergraduate, MA, or PhD student

Authorship of Nominated Paper

- Sole authored
- Co-authored papers are acceptable but the submitter must be the primary contributor. Note: Authorship may be confirmed by RC Award Committee.

Conference Presentation of Nominated Paper

- Presentation in a Canadian Sociological Association Conference hosted session
- Paper must be accepted for presentation in an Animals in Society affiliated session

Nominated Paper Status

• Submission may be in any stage of publication (unpublished, submitted and approved but not yet published, or published in the past 6 months)

Nominated Paper Format

- Maximum 30 pages in length, exclusive of title page, references, and appendices
- English submissions preferred

Submission Instructions:

- Co-author name(s), affiliation(s), and student level(s), as applicable
