Eligibility Criteria:

Primary Author of Nominated Paper

- Canadian Sociological Association membership in good standing
- MA Student OR PhD Student

Authorship of Nominated Paper

• Sole authored OR Co-authored with another student (undergraduate, MA, or PhD)

Conference Presentation of Nominated Paper

• Presentation in a Canadian Sociological Association Conference hosted session

Nominated Paper Status

• Unpublished and not yet approved for publication

Nominated Paper Format

- Maximum 25 pages
- Submissions will be accepted in English
