

CSA-SCS: 2024 Sociology of Health Research Cluster Best Student Paper Award



The [Sociology of Health Research Cluster](#) is now accepting nominations for our Best Student Paper Award. The paper must address the themes of the cluster, broadly defined as a focus on health, illness, and/or medicine. The paper can be empirical or theoretical in focus, but should involve original research (e.g., not a literature review or synthesis). One recipient will be selected from the nominees.

Eligibility Criteria:

Primary Author of Nominated Paper

- The primary author must be a member of CSA.
- The primary author must be an MA or PhD student.

Authorship of Nominated Paper

- The paper can be solo-authored **OR** co-authored with another student.

Conference Presentation of Nominated Paper

- The paper is going to be presented at CSA.

Nominated Paper Format

- The paper is no longer than 10,000 words.
- Submissions can be in French or English.

Submission Instructions:

Papers must be submitted no later than April 15th 2024, and we plan to make a final decision by May 15th 2024.

1. Name, email address, affiliation, and student-level of all authors.
2. The CSA session in which the paper will be presented.
3. Authors are welcome, but not required, to identify members of an equity deserving group (e.g., "I identify as a member of an equity deserving group" is sufficient).
