

Refer to the Preliminary Session List for session descriptions and organizer contact information.


Click the drop-down menu to view sessions open to abstract submissions.

You may contact the session organizer(s) before submitting your abstract to discuss whether your research/paper would be a good fit in their session.

Notes:

- An abstract may only be submitted to ONE session.
- A maximum of two (2) different abstracts may be submitted to two (2) different sessions.


Authors who submit abstracts to this conference agree to the following terms:


