## PREPARING TO JOB SEEK

- Establish personal goals
  - What field of work are you interested in?
  - What work do you want to be doing?
  - What type of institutional environment do you want to work in?
- Request feedback
  - Be open to critique from mentors, peers, and supervisors and apply it to alter your jobseeking documentation and strategies
- Find inspiration
  - Find individuals in your field or field of interest that you admire and help motivate you
- Keep your search focused
